Subject: FCC Status and U.S. Eligibility of Wingtra UAS

Wingtra AG provides this statement in response to inquiries regarding the status of Wingtra unmanned aircraft systems (UAS) under Federal Communications Commission (FCC) regulations, **as in effect and publicly updated as of January 7, 2026**, and their continued eligibility for use in the United States.

This statement applies to **all Wingtra UAS models currently released and in service, as well as all payloads that have been released or publicly announced by Wingtra as of the date of this letter.**

On December 22, 2025, the FCC updated its Covered List to include UAS and UAS critical components produced in a foreign country. On January 7, 2026, following a determination by the Department of War (DoW), the FCC further updated the Covered List to **exempt UAS and UAS critical components included on the Defense Contract Management Agency's (DCMA) Blue UAS Cleared List.**

Wingtra UAS and applicable payloads are included on the DCMA Blue UAS Cleared List.

Accordingly, under the FCC's current rules and guidance, **Wingtra UAS are not subject to the FCC Covered List restrictions applicable to foreign-produced UAS**, and there is no FCC action that prohibits the lawful sale, importation, operation, or continued use of Wingtra UAS that have been placed into service in the United States.

Wingtra continues to monitor U.S. regulatory developments and will communicate any material changes that may affect customers or partners.
